

Invasive Non-native Plant Management: Bear Creek and Hwy 95 Intersection

- Problem invasive species included kudzu.
- Invasives threatened walnut plantation and presented aesthetic impact.
- Kudzu treated with high-volume foliar spray of Tordon 101 by CSC in 2004 through 2006.
