



Existing and Potential Grass Areas on ORR



Native Warm Season Grasses on the Oak Ridge Reservation (ORR)

- **What:** Convert areas on ORR to native grasses
- **Why:** To improve biodiversity, provide wildlife habitat, meet regulatory requirements, and produce biomass
- **Where:** Abandoned fields, ROW, waste caps, and other open habitats
